# **RHAindustry Login Tips**


This document contains the most common problems users have when trying to login to RHAindustry. If you have thoroughly read and performed these tips and still cannot login, please contact IT Support for help.

## **Your First Login**

When your RHA Industry account is created by a member of the IS Team, you will receive an email from RHAindustry (admin@rhaindustry.com) with the subject line of "Your Site Account" with the following information:



## Follow these steps to get your account fully set up:

- 1. Create a password
  - a. Click on the "Set Password" link in the email you received. You will see the page below:



- b. Alternatively, if you did not receive the email above, go to <u>Resetting Your Password</u> below and follow those steps this will also get your account setup finished.
- 2. Login for the first time! Now you should communicate with your Program's staff to understand how your program works in RHAindustry and to get properly trained on using it.

#### **Helpful Tips:**

- Make sure to **click the link to set your password when you receive this email**, even if you aren't going to use the site immediately.
- **Take note of your login name** it will not be an email address. It is usually some combination of your first name and last name (first initial+last name, first name+ last name, etc., and for RHA employees, may not be the same as your RHA login).
- Bookmark www.rhaindustry.com in your browser, for easier access later.

## **Resetting Your Password**

If you've forgotten your password, or are otherwise having login issues, resetting your password can sometimes help. Please follow these instructions to reset your password:

1. Go to www.rhaindustry.com. If you are not logged in, you are presented with the following:



2. Click the "Lost Password?" link. You will see this box:



3. Enter your email address, and click "Reset." You will then see the box below.

Do not do anything in this box – go to your email inbox for next steps!



## And you will receive this email:



4. Click the "Set Password" link in the email above, after which you are presented with this page on RHAindustry:




5. After entering a new password in both boxes, click Reset. At this point, your password is now changed.


If you have stored your credentials in your browser, follow the instructions in the next section to correctly change your stored credentials, if you are still having problems logging in after resetting your password.

## **Correcting Stored Credentials after a Password Reset**


1. Go to www.rhaindustry.com. If you are already logged in, click the "LOGOUT" link in the top right corner of the page, if it is there. If you are not logged in, you will not see this link.



2. In the login box, manually **type over any pre-filled username and/or password** - do not use the pre-populated information that the browser automatically fills in.



3. Click the Login button, but **do not let the browser save the credentials**. Select "Not Now" or "Later" or some equivalent, depending on your browser, when you are presented with a box similar to this in your browser:



**NOTE:** If you are not successfully logged into RHAindustry at this point, something is wrong and you should reset your password and start over, following each instruction very carefully. **Do not continue here if you are not successfully logged in.** 

- 4. **Now we repeat this process**. Start by clicking the "LOGOUT" link in RHAindustry as in step 1 above.
- 5. In the login box (shown in step 2 above), manually **type over any pre-filled username and/or password** do not use the pre-populated information that the browser automatically fills in.
- 6. **If login is successful at this point** (if you are not successfully logged in at this point, do not continue), you can click "Update" to save the new credentials in the browser if that is what you choose to do (it is not mandatory, and is actually more secure if you do not store or write down your credentials).
